The beauty of extended expeditions includes heightened appreciation, greater responsibilities, increased capabilities and a new perspective.

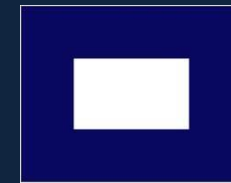

The “Blue Peter” - maritime signal flag P (“PAPA”) is traditionally flown by ships in harbour, to announce preparation to sail, summoning “all hands report to the ship”.

For many generations, this has been used as a symbol for youth development programs that utilise marine adventures.
