Thank you for such thoughtfully prepared and stimulating training. From the first telephone call, when planning the training package, I noticed your desire to shape the training to the specific needs of our setting – a high secure forensic mental health hospital. It was different from training sessions that I have previously arranged. I really appreciated your willingness, flexibility and creativity throughout. We asked for training and support for our clinical staff to develop more ‘creative’ approaches to therapeutic group work. You delivered much more.

Over the course of a one week training program, I observed our therapy staff (the training participants) bond and work together more collaboratively than ever, and with an enjoyment that I have not seen before. They were provided with a high challenge training package in a high support environment. Each participant gave positive feedback, and a number have said it is the ‘best training’ they have received.
