Where to go on the first day of your Sea School expedition



Refer to the map below - to get there from the Victoria Point Shopping Centre, follow **Colburn Avenue** to the end and **turn left** to find the Western boat ramp in front of the **Volunteer Marine Rescue** Station.


There is ample parking available for extended times on top of the hill and also if the gates are open to the grassed area in the north western corner of the point (closest to where we meet).

A brick toilet block can be found beside the playground - along with BBQ facilities, picnic tables and fresh water taps.

Please get yourself ready before the start time - arrive early to get organised, go to the toilet and lock up vehicles etc. We like to start on time with everyone present.

Unless otherwise arranged, the meeting place and time is 0930 under the trees beside the Victoria Point Volunteer Marine Rescue Station. You will often see our boats parked there ready for action!

Think about your hopes and concerns for the expedition, write down any questions and feel free to ask us anything.

Typically we start with a rope circle, acknowledging the Quandamooka Elders, and doing some introductions. Please share something about your interest and experience level (even if it still has a lot of potential!) We discuss expedition behavior and the importance of encouragement and positive feedback for each other to help create the best learning environment.

Have your gear already organised as described in the what to bring list. Your day pack should have snacks, water, sun protection and your lunch for the first day along with a rain jacket. Even in fine weather this can be useful if it is windy.

Perishable or frozen food can be placed in the esky, it is helpful to have separate bags for each meal.

If you have forgotten anything please ask – we usually have spare clothing and equipment available.
